



LEGION STADIUM FUNDRAISING INFORMATION

Thank you for your interest in fundraising opportunities at Legion Stadium. We are pleased to offer you an exciting way to raise money for your organization.

Legion Stadium, operated by the City of Wilmington, is home to New Hanover High School Athletics; the United Soccer League's Wilmington Hammerheads; and the North American Football League's Port City Diesel. Other special events also take place at the stadium.

Legion provides opportunities for fundraising by hosting volunteers to work at these games and special events. Organizations are invited to provide members, parents and friends as staff for Legion's concession stands. Typical groups that volunteer are booster clubs, civic organizations and churches.

Groups have found volunteering at concessions stands to be a dependable way to raise significant funds for their organization. The work schedule is flexible and reliable, and most of all, it's fun! The best part is by having local groups volunteer, revenues are returned to the community.

Fundraising Conditions

- Stands require a minimum of 10 to 14 volunteers to operate. Beer portables require a minimum of two people to operate.
- Age requirements: Group members must be at least 18 years old to volunteer at events that serve alcohol. Group members must be at least 21 to serve alcohol. At least seven volunteers must be 21 in your stand. Group members must be at least 16 years old to volunteer at events that do not serve alcohol. Proof of age will be required to volunteer in stands.
- Each group must identify a group leader who will be in charge of your stand. The City will provide an employee in your stands to support you with cooking, inventory management, and general assistance.
- Groups will work between 4 and 6 hours per event.
- Volunteers must wear long pants, closed toes shoes, and a hat or hair restraint. Dress codes are strictly enforced!
- Your group will be provided a sign identifying your group.
- **General Terms:** Groups must sign a one-year contract. Groups must agree to work a minimum of five events and attend one training session. The commission is 12% on all food and beverages sales. A bonus may be offered to groups that successfully take over a stand from which another volunteer group has cancelled on within a 48-hour period. Volunteers may receive one complimentary meal, depending upon the nature of the event. Free promotional tickets for certain events are sometimes provided as incentives. Stands are assigned on a first come, first served basis. New Hanover High School Athletic Boosters will have scheduling priority.
