Pursuant to North Carolina General Statute 143-129, sealed proposals addressed to the Purchasing Manager, P. O. Box 1810, 305 Chestnut Street, 5th Floor, Wilmington, NC 28402, and marked "Civil Access Improvements Bid Package IV, Project No. PB-JS-0212 will be received until 2:00 p.m., Thursday, February 23, 2012 at which time they will be publicly opened and read at the Purchasing Division, 305 Chestnut Street, 5th Floor, Wilmington, NC. The City will receive SINGLE PRIME BIDS ONLY for this project.

This project consists of work which includes but is not limited to repairs and improvements to the showers, restrooms, concessions and office areas at the City swimming pool facilities. The scope includes renovations for ADA compliance and follows the DOJ inspection list of non compliant conditions for these locations. The work includes concrete sidewalk revisions, relocation of plumbing fixtures, casework repairs, reworking/replacing toilet partitions and grab bars, and CMU repair.

All firms submitting bids for the proposed work must be properly licensed under Chapter 87, N. C. General Statutes. The bidder's license number must appear on the outside of the envelope. In accordance with Chapter 2 of the Wilmington City Code, all firms submitting bids for this project must complete pre-qualification forms and receive pre-qualification approval by the City of Wilmington, in order to be considered for this work. Bids received from firms that are not pre-qualified will not be opened.

In accordance with the City of Wilmington's Minority/Disadvantaged Business Policy, the bidder shall make good faith efforts, as defined by the Bid Specifications, to subcontract 14% of the dollar value of the prime contract to businesses which are at least 51% owned and controlled by minority, socially, and/or economically disadvantaged individuals (MBE/DBE's).

Potential Subcontract opportunities which may exist on this project include, but may not be limited to Masonry, Carpentry, Painting, Toilet & Bath Accessories, Dry Wall, Plumbing, Curb & Gutter, Concrete, Pavement Markings, Suppliers and other items not specifically referenced herein.

If the bidder fails to achieve the contract goal stated herein, it is required to provide documentation demonstrating that it made a good faith effort in attempting to meet the established goals. A bid which fails to meet these requirements will be considered non-responsive and will be rejected.

A Mandatory Pre-Bid Conference will be held at 2:00 p.m., Thursday, February 9, 2012 at Legion Stadium, 2149 Carolina Beach Road, Wilmington, NC. All parties interested in the project must attend the Pre-Bid Conference.
