## DIRECTIONS

### **From I-40 East**

1. Take the US-17/US-74 ramp towards WILMINGTON.
2. Turn LEFT onto US-17 S/US-74 W (Market St.)
3. Turn LEFT onto Third Street
4. Go straight through the next 4 stop lights
5. Take a LEFT onto Willard Street
6. Take a RIGHT into parking lot at Greenfield Park

### **From 74/76 East**

1. Cross Cape Fear Memorial Bridge to Wilmington
2. Stay in right lane
3. At light, turn RIGHT onto 3rd Street
4. Go through 1 stop light
5. Take a LEFT onto Willard Street
6. Take a RIGHT into parking lot at Greenfield Park

# Park Rules & Regulations



1. All skaters must have a waiver signed and on file. Skaters under the age of 18 must have a waiver signed by a parent or legal guardian.
2. Skaters **MUST** wear helmets, knee-pads and elbow pads at all times, **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
3. Skaters should always check the condition of their gear to make sure it is in safe working order.
4. Skate at your own risk.
5. Only one person per skateboard
6. Skateboards and in-line skates are allowed in designated areas only. No skating in the parking lots or on the sidewalks.
7. Skating permitted only during designated hours.
8. Skate area is closed during inclement weather.
9. Reckless or dangerous skaters will be requested to leave the skating area and the premises immediately.



10. All injuries whether major or minor in nature, are to be reported to the management immediately. In case of a serious injury, do not move the injured person and all skating in that area shall cease immediately
11. Lock all personal belongings in your car or leave them at home. The City is not responsible for stolen or lost items.
12. No refunds will be given!
13. No bicycles, roller skates, or scooters are permitted in the skateboard area.
14. No chewing gum in the skateboard park; no food, beverage, or glass in the skate areas.
15. No alcohol, controlled substances, or weapons on property.
16. No smoking, profanity, graffiti, or fighting.
17. Spectators and patrons of the park should never enter the skating area of the park for any reason.
18. Staff has the right to deny entry of a participant if they are under the influence of drugs or alcohol, or there is evidence of attempts to circumvent established safety rules or demonstrate conduct that will be unacceptable to the users in the park.
19. No children under the age of 12 years will be permitted without supervision.
20. Due to insurance restrictions, children under the age of 7 will not be permitted in the park.
