

1995 & 1998 Annexation Areas Storm Water Master Plan and Mapping

Year Funded: 2000

Cost: \$925,000

Description: The City of Wilmington filed for annexations in 1995 and 1998 which ultimately increased the jurisdictional land area of the City by approximately 20 square miles. This project had two main purposes; 1) to map the existing drainage system in this 20 square mile area and 2) to analyze drainage problem areas. The mapping phase of the project provides information to be used by drainage maintenance crews on a daily basis. The analysis phase assisted in planning for future needs to improve drainage infrastructure within these two annexation areas.
