

**PROCLAMATION TERMINATING DECLARATION OF
STATE OF EMERGENCY IN THE CITY OF WILMINGTON**

Winter Storm Gianna presented an imminent threat of severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property to the City of Wilmington.

Mayor Saffo declared a state of emergency on January 30, 2026 at 4:30 p.m. pursuant to Section 6-17 of the Wilmington City Code.

As Mayor of the City of Wilmington, pursuant to Section 6-17 of the City Code, I have determined that a state of emergency no longer exists in the City of Wilmington.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Saffo, Mayor of the City of Wilmington, do hereby declare that a state of emergency in the City of Wilmington has ended.

This proclamation shall be effective February 4th, 2026 at 2:00 AM/PM.
