# WILMINGTON MUNICIPAL GOLF COURSE GREENS PROTECTION NOTICE

Due to the forecasted risk of ice and freezing temperatures in the mid-to-low 20s, the Municipal Golf Course will cover the ultra-dwarf greens beginning **Friday, January 23, at 2 PM**. This proactive measure is intended to protect the greens from ice damage and winterkill. Based on current forecasts, the covers will remain in place through **Monday, February 2, 2026**.

If conditions improve, the removal date will be adjusted and normal operations will resume. Greens covers — specialized, permeable turf blankets — help shield vulnerable grasses like ultra-dwarf Bermuda from extreme cold, ice, and drying conditions. This protection supports turf health, preserves color, and promotes earlier spring play while balancing site conditions and operational needs.
