The meeting started at 9:20 AM with a review of the Transportation chapter draft.

Christine Hughes presented a draft of the Transportation chapter. As review of the chapter began, Ms. Hughes that there are currently 408 miles of city-owned streets and 101 miles of state-owned roads within the city limits.

Discussion centered around finding the balance between a pedestrian-friendly city and a car-friendly city, the purpose and function of an MPO, an educational program for drivers and cyclists regarding bicycle rules and rights, the role of parking and parking regulations in transportation policies. The current transportation impact analysis process was also discussed, including the need to consider other factors beyond simply peak AM and PM trip generation, including internal capture and the overall multi-modal network.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:25 AM.
