CHANGE IT!

What changes you would make

More sidewalks, crosswalks and bike lanes, more code enforcement, more walking and biking trails, no more multi-family development, reduce crime, more traffic and speed limit enforcement, widen the Cross City Trail, improve traffic flow on major roads, make Wrightsville Avenue and Wilshire Boulevard one-way streets, allow more garage apartments, utilize roundabouts, more traffic calming on Wilshire Boulevard and Bonham and Park avenues, protect historic resources, maintain residential character, change how neighborhoods are notified of pending development, make sure new multi-family is sensitive to the character of the neighborhood, and convert manufactured housing parks into single-family

Your big ideas

Sidewalks and bike lanes on major streets and crosswalks at major intersections, more walking and biking paths, single-family homes throughout neighborhoods, community gardens, more code enforcement, make College Road and Kerr Avenue one-way through Winter Park, pedestrian bridges over College Road and Oleander Drive, walking and biking loop around Randall Pond, bring back the trolley, more bike parking in commercial areas, historic district designation, traffic calming on neighborhood streets, bus stop improvements, underground utilities, reduce crime, improve streetscape along College Road and Oleander Drive, more roundabouts, fewer rental properties, fix pot holes, and more parks and recreation activities
