

WHAT WE HEARD

The primary exercise at the Neighborhood Planning Area meetings collected ideas based on three primary questions:

KEEP IT! What do you like most?

- Trees, natural areas, and green spaces
- Existing residential density and character
- Clean and accessible creeks and waterways
- Neighborhood school within walking distance
- Local restaurants and mixed use areas
- Safe, quiet, and crime free neighborhood
- 25 mph speed limit
- Our parks
- Golf course

CHANGE IT! What are the biggest issues?

- More bike lanes and sidewalks
- Improve stormwater drainage system
- Update or remove the sewage station
- Lower and enforce speed limits
- Improve the water quality of the creeks
- Intersection improvements at Beasley/Pine Grove
- Protect more natural areas and green spaces
- More historic markers, monuments and signs


DREAM IT! What is your big idea?

- More neighborhood connections




Current Population




Population Change




Planning Area Location




Age Composition




Housing Occupancy and Values




Land Use Distribution




Household Income
