Increase safety, reduce crime, combat gang activity, limit access to Creekwood, add police substation, add community center and more recreation facilities for kids, more programs for kids, slow neighborhood traffic, improve traffic flow on Market Street, pave streets, more street lights, more sidewalks, limit on-street parking on narrow streets, trim vegetation in rights-of-way to improve sight distance, improve drainage, more senior housing, complete Independence Boulevard extension
