CHANGE IT!

What changes you would make

More sidewalks, bike lanes and bike paths, improve stormwater drainage, improve intersection of Greenville Loop and Pine Grove roads, eliminate sewer small from pump station, lower traffic speeds, more public access to creeks, more compatible uses along Oleander Drive, more street lighting, clean up vacant lots, no more sewer leaks into creeks, bike and pedestrian bridge over Bradley Creek, pave Greenville Loop Road, keep road rights-of-way clean, improve traffic flow on Greenville Loop Road, new park on south side of Oleander Drive, limit density, traffic calming within neighborhoods, and pedestrian crossings on Oleander Drive

Sidewalks, crosswalks, bike lanes and bike paths, better storm water drainage, limited density, slower traffic on Greenville Loop Road, improved function of major intersections, neighborhood park, more bike and pedestrian connections within neighborhoods, underground utilities, repave streets, dog parks, rainwater gardens, public access to the water, improvements to waste water pump stations and synchronized traffic signals
