What you like most about your neighborhood

Residential character and family atmosphere, access to groceries, shopping and entertainment, schools and educational opportunities, parks and open spaces, access to healthcare, bike and pedestrian facilities, trees, recreational opportunities, neighborhood businesses, speed limit and low number of traffic signals on Wrightsville Avenue, low-traffic alleyways, Wrightsville Avenue development regulations, safe community, the cemetery and diversity

CHANGE IT!

What changes you would make

More code enforcement for yard sales, permitted structures, number of occupants, junk cars, trash and property maintenance, more lighting and sidewalks, slower neighborhood traffic, address the impact of the student population on the neighborhood (parties, vandalism, litter, parking, property damage), collaborate with UNCW, better upkeep of rental properties, hold landlords accountable, intersection improvements and College and Oleander, College and Park, and Wallace and Wrightsville, include area in university parking ordinance, bike lanes and sidewalks on Wrightsville Avenue, more police patrols, improved traffic flow on Wrightsville Avenue, address noise from adjacent areas (UNCW, hospital, Jingle Rapids), limit/prohibit onstreet parking, improve drainage, and improve the River to the Sea Bikeway

DREAM IT!

Your big ideas

Pedestrian bridge/crosswalk across Oleander at Pine Grove to access park, more sidewalks, crosswalks, bike lanes and trails, less congestion on College Rd and Oleander Dr, lower traffic speeds, more code enforcement of number of occupants and property maintenance, bike lanes and sidewalks on Wrightsville Avenue, traffic signals at Wrightsville and Wallace and Wrightsville and Rose, save and plant more trees, lower density, more parks and open space, protect the residential character, better maintenance of the River to the Sea Bikeway, reduce college parties (create a place for students to party), improve property maintenance (hold landlords accountable), bring back the trolley, bury utilities, close Woodale Dr at UNCW, and extend Randall Parkway through university to Hooker Rd
