Moore's Creek

Date: 5/15 Time: 9 am – 2 pm

Ages: 16 and up

Cost: \$45/person

Enjoy a leisurely paddle along this black water creek that flows into the Black River. We'll have plenty of opportunities to see wildlife paddling through hardwood and cypress swamp forest. This trip includes a guided tour of Moore's Creek National Battlefield with National Park Service staff.

Eagles Island

Date: 6/12 Time: 8:30 am - 11:30 am

Ages: 16 and up Cost: \$45

We'll paddle Sturgeon Creek to the Brunswick River and then explore the beauty of Eagle Island, 3,100 acres located between Leland and Wilmington, NC. Along the way there will be plenty of opportunities to see wildlife and take in the scenic beauty of the river. We'll take out at Belville Riverwalk Park.

Mott's Creek

Date: 7/10 Time: 5:30 pm - 8:30 pm

Ages: 16 and up Cost: \$45

We'll meet at River Road Park and explore Motts Creek on this sunset adventure. This is a leisurely trip and we'll have time to explore Shark's Tooth Island on the return paddle. This is a perfect trip for beginners.

Smith Creek

Ages: 16 and up Cost: \$45

We'll launch along Burnt Mill Creek and explore Smith Creek a hidden gem in the City of Wilmington. Along the way we'll travel by the MLK Parkway, ILM airport and into the upper reaches of the creek. This paddle provides an interesting perspective due to the juxtaposition of the urban and natural landscape.
