Pursuant to North Carolina General Statute 143-129, sealed proposals addressed to the Purchasing Manager, P. O. Box 1810, 305 Chestnut Street, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, Wilmington, NC 28402, and marked "5<sup>th</sup> & Dawson/ Wooster Pedestrian Improvements Williston-Gregory Sidewalks No. SW/PS-IH-1118" will be received until 3:00 p.m., Tuesday, December 4, 2018 at which time they will be publicly opened and read at 305 Chestnut Street, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Wilmington, NC. The City will receive SINGLE PRIME BIDS ONLY for this project.

Project Description : This work includes 2 projects with separate plans and bid items as follows: 1) 5<sup>th</sup> and Dawson/Wooster Pedestrian Improvements includes asphalt removal/repair, curb and gutter, curb ramps, sidewalk, drainage, striping and pedestrian signals. 2) Williston/Gregory Sidewalks – Phase 1 project includes the construction of approximately 1,300 linear feet of sidewalk along 13<sup>th</sup> Street, installation and replacement of existing curb ramps along 13<sup>th</sup> Street from Dawson Street to Castle Street and along 10<sup>th</sup> Street from Dawson Street to Queen Street, replacement of existing curb and a minor modification to the existing storm sewer to accommodate new curb ramps, and installation of pedestrian push buttons and pedestrian signal heads at signalized intersections within the project limits.

All firms submitting bids for the proposed work must be properly licensed under Chapter 87, North Carolina General Statutes. The bidder's license number must appear on the outside of the envelope. Bidders are required to be prequalified with NCDOT for their specific discipline in order to be considered for this work. Please refer to Section 102-2 of the NCDOT 2012 Standard Specifications. Contractors wishing to become prequalified may obtain information through the NCDOT webs <http://www.ncdot.gov/business/>. Bids received from firms that are not pre-qualified will not be opened.

In accordance with the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) Disadvantaged Business Enterprise, the bidder shall make good faith efforts, as defined by the Bid Specifications, to subcontract 2% DBE of the dollar value of the prime contract to businesses which are at least 51% owned and controlled by minority, socially, and/or economically disadvantaged individuals (DBE'S).

Potential Subcontract opportunities which may exist on this project include, but may not be limited to Concrete, Curb and Gutter, Hauling, Grading, Asphalt Paving, Landscaping, Traffic Control, Pavement Markings and Markers, Erosion Control, Signal Work, Suppliers and other items not specifically referenced herein.

If the bidder fails to achieve the contract goal stated herein, it is required to provide documentation demonstrating that it made a good faith effort in attempting to meet the established goals. A bid which fails to meet these requirements will be considered non-responsive and will be rejected.

A Pre-Bid Conference was previously held at 3:00 p.m., November 1, 2018 at 305 Chestnut Street 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, Wilmington, NC. All parties interested in the project were invited to attend.
